

Church Of The Most Precious Blood, Borough, London, 2013



The unusually located 19th century Church of the Most Precious Blood.



Fortunately the existing floor was flat and level enough to accept the JUPITER IDEAL system as soon as the pews were removed.



Following the installation of a damp proof membrane 120mm rigid insulation was loose laid.



The JUPITER heating panels were then installed rapidly followed by the heating pipe work.



Once the heating was installed, the system was covered with a slip membrane and then tiles with the Screed Replacement Tile



As a stop gap the Screed Replacement Tile substrate was used as a temporary surface before the final stone is installed.
